## **Sampling Tools needed to take a soil test:**

Soil sample probe, shovel, spade or spoon and a small pail.

## **Collecting the Soil Sample:**

When collecting soil, scrape away any plant residue and sample about 6 inches deep, or the depth of the planned tillage. Collect all the samples together in a plastic pail and mix thoroughly, then take enough soil from the pail to fill the sample bag, or small ziplock bag, halfway full. **Be sure to take several core samples** from the area that you intend to plant your “Whitetail Select” food plot.
